
Philosophy 4940--Topics in the Philosophy of Health, Illness, and Medicine

This course will explore central philosophical theories of health, illness, and mental disorders as well as a critical examination of the possibilities and limits of medicine. Topics to be addressed include:

- 1. How birth and death shape our sense of self and how culture and health care practices transform our relationship to them.
- 2. The complexity of the connection between the experience of illness and the body as understood clinically.
- 3. How philosophies of disability complicate our understanding of normality and pathology.
- 4. The impact of political and corporate practices on the nature of health care and our understanding of it.
- 5. The impact of shifting mental health diagnoses and definitions.
