Fire	 If you see smoke or fit sounding, immediately Grab your bag, cell ph Evacuate from the buil fashion, using the stair Close all doors on you Do not re-enter the b 	Never ignore an alarm! If you see smoke or fire and no alarm is sounding, immediately call UTCPD. Grab your bag, cell phone, keys, & wallet. Evacuate from the building in an orderly fashion, using the stairs. Close all doors on your way out. Do not re-enter the building until advised by first responders / University officials.		•	Call UTCPD. Send a person outside to direct emergency responders. Send a person to get the AED, Bleeding Control Kit, First Aid Kit, or Naloxone, if needed. Provide care to the level that you are trained, if any. Do not move the victim unless necessary.		
Severe Weather	•	Postpone outdoor activities.		•	Go to designated shelter space or the lowest, interior space of the building that you can access. Take cover, protect your head and neck. Shelter until an "All Clear" is issued via UTC Alert System.

Turn off ventilation system by pulling fire alarm system pull station. Follow directions and be prepared to evacuate if directed by first responders / University officials.		
Bomb Threat	 If the threat is received via letter, emails, or packages, immediately call UTCPD. If the threat is received via telephone: Keep the caller on the telephone. Have another person contact UTCPD immediately; do not alert the caller. Listen carefully, be polite, and show interest in what the caller is saying. Try to keep the caller talking so you can learn as much information as possible. Document any information that appears on Caller ID. 		Armed Intruder	•	RUN: If you have knowledge of the assailant's location and you have a clear path to an exit. HIDE: Close, lock, and barricade doors and windows. Seek cover in an inconspicuous location. Silence your cell phone. Be as silent as possible. FIGHT: As a last resort and only if your life is in immediate danger, attempt to stop the assailant.
